How many reps/sets? Ex. 10 reps of pushups for 3 sets.</p>	<p><u>Library</u></p> <p>Choose a nonfiction book from your home library to read. Fold a piece of paper into 4 sections and write down 1 fact in each section.</p>	<p><u>STEM</u></p> <p>Cardboard car: Carboard box and art supplies. Use the supplies to make your box into a car, boat or truck.</p>
<p><u>PE</u></p> <p>Design your own obstacle course using household items. How fast can you complete it?</p>	<p><u>STEM</u></p> <p>Challenge your child to build with plastic cups. Can they build a tower as tall as you? Can they make a building shaped like a triangle.</p>	<p><u>MUSIC</u></p> <p>Teach a game you learned in music class to someone at your house.</p>	<p><u>Art</u></p> <p>Make a treasure box. Cut out pictures from old magazines and glue them to the outside of a shoe box.</p>	<p><u>Library</u></p> <p>Read a book. Choose an illustration from the book and act it out!</p>

(cards, sport, board game, etc.)</p>	<p><u>MUSIC</u></p> <p>Dance along with a GoNoodle video. **can be found on youtube*</p>	<p><u>Art</u></p> <p>Use sidewalk chalk and draw a garden with flowers and insects.</p>	<p><u>STEM</u></p> <p>Use cushions, pillows and blankets to make a cushion fort. How many people can fit in your cushion fort?</p>	<p><u>Library</u></p> <p>Read a book about your favorite animal. You can use EPIC or Pebble Go. Draw a picture and write facts you learned.</p>
<p><u>MUSIC</u></p> <p>Listen to "Spring" by Vivaldi. Find a scarf and move to the music. **can be found on youtube**</p>	<p><u>PE</u></p> <p>Tidy up while walking like a crab! Carry items on your belly across the room to put them away.</p>	<p><u>STEM</u></p> <p>Gather some small objects, plastic toys, coin, a pebble, a leaf, a stick, etc. Fill a small container with water and see if the objects sink or float.</p>	<p><u>Library</u></p> <p>Flashlight Reading. Choose a book to read and read it with a flashlight.</p>	<p><u>Art</u></p> <p>Tic Tac Toe- Make a giant version of tic tac toe on a sidewalk outside. Challenge your family to a game of tic tac toe.</p>
